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One thing to try differently next time — phrase it as a behavior, not a trait

A moment where you weren't sure what they were doing — describe it neutrally

RULE OF THUMB

If your feedback could be copy-pasted onto anyone in the room, it isn't feedback yet. Name the moment, quote the words, describe the effect.
